Whole House 20" Pre-filter Cartridge Replacement

Replace the pre-filter if there is a noticeable reduction of flow through the filter system, or if the pre-filter cartridge becomes heavily discolored.

Every 6 months. (Frequency may vary based on water quality and sediment levels)





How to change the pre-filter:

- 1. Shut off water to the system (A). Relieve water pressure in the pre-filter by slowly turning the pressure relief knob (B) counterclockwise until water stops running.
- 2. Place a bucket under the pre-filter to catch water. Remove the blue chamber by unscrewing it with the provided wrench.
- 3. If necessary, clean the inside of with mild soapy water, rinse and dry.
- 4. Place new filter in the center of the blue chamber.
- 5. Clean the housing o-ring and relubricate it with silicone grease. Seat the o-ring into the proper groove and reattach the housing by screwing back onto the top piece.
 NOTE: DO NOT USE PETROLEUM JELLY as lubrication on the system or o-rings.
- After reassembly, turn the water to the system back on by slowly opening the shutoff valve.
- 7. To remove air from the lines, run water with the bucket still under the pre-filter. Check for leaks.
