# **Filter Replacements**

Low Maintenance Pre-Filter Cartridge Replacement (EQ-PRE-204-R)

Iron Filter Cartridge Replacement (EQ-FE20-R)

10" Post-Filter Cartridge Replacement (EQ-PFC.35)

**Replace every 6 months.** Frequency may vary based on amount of iron and sediment levels in the water. Replace sooner if there is a noticable decrease in water flow through the filter system.

Filter housing must be replaced every 5 years. To replace, call Customer Support.

# 1 Shut Off Water Supply

- Turn off the main water source prior to filter replacement or turn off the shut-off valve. If using your bypass valve, shut off both sides of the bypass valve.
- 2. Drain water from lines to relieve pressure by turning on a faucet inside your home. When using the bypass method, you do not need to drain water from the lines.


#### **ELECTRICAL SHOCK HAZARD**

If you have copper pipes - leave your grounding clamps installed. Do not disconnect at any time while changing the tank. Failure to follow this instruction can result in death or electric shock.

# 2 Remove Used Filter

 Release pressure from the Pre-Filter, Iron Filter, and Post-Filter by unscrewing the pressure-relief valve located on the sump cap. If you are only changing one filter, you only need to release pressure from that sump.

**NOTE:** You must relieve the pressure in your system before attempting to change any filter.



- 2. Remove the bottoms of the filter housings from the sump caps.
- 3. Remove the used filter cartridges and discard accordingly.

#### **AWARNING**


Filter housings will be extremely heavy - DO NOT DROP. Dropping the housing will likely cause plastic to crack.

### (3) Insert New Filters

- 1. Inspect the filters to ensure that the filters have not been damaged and there is no plastic or other objects stuck to the filters.
- 2. Wipe filter housings clean using cold water and a soft sponge.
- 3. Insert the Pre-Filter into the first housing labeled "Pre-Filter". Insert the Iron Filter into the housing labeled "Iron-Filter". Insert the Post-Filter into the 10" Post-Filter housing.

**NOTE:** The notch in the bottom of the housing centers the filter cartridges.

- 4. Clean the O-rings and relubricate with silicone grease. Re-seat the O-ring into the proper groove of the housing. **DO NOT** use petroleum jelly.
- 5. Manually tighten the housings to the sump caps. Then, using the sump wrench provided with your original system, fully tighten the housings. **DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.**



**NOTE:** You should only need to use the wrench for ½ to ¼ of a turn.



- 1. Slowly turn on the main water supply or shut-off valve. If you have a bypass system, open both ends of the bypass.
- 2. Wait for air to purge from the pressure-relief valves and then turn and tighten the valves closed.
- 3. Once system has fully pressurized, inspect for leaks.

  After inspecting for leaks, turn on the faucet closest to the installed unit and allow water to run for 5 minutes for the final flushing period.

#### **Precautions**

- Properly tighten all fittings to ensure a leak-free assembly.
- Use only certified, genuine Aquasana replacement filters for continued contaminant removal and system performance. Performance Data Sheet information can be found at Aquasana.com.
- DO NOT use with water that is microbiologically unsafe or of unknown water quality without adequate disinfection before or after the system. Systems certified for cyst reduction may be used on disinfected waters that may contain filterable cysts.
